It took place in June 13th a webinar to discuss about AEO and its relationship with origin.

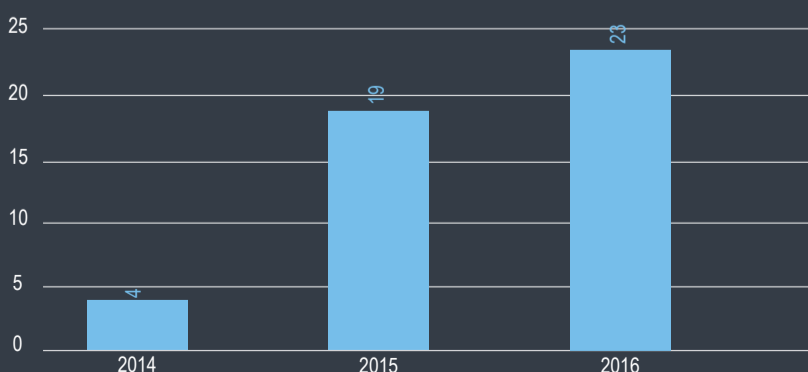
It was conducted by María Iiris Cespedes Núñez, who described the main features of Authorized Economic Operators, operation and implications of mutual recognition.
