This event will pave the way for enhanced future cooperation and will support all stakeholders amidst a dynamic and rapidly changing international business environment. With this in mind, I look forward to welcoming you at the Joint Conference.

This Conference will also allow Customs executives to meet a wide crosssection of government and private sector representatives to discuss issues surrounding air cargo security in particular and supply chain security in general.
